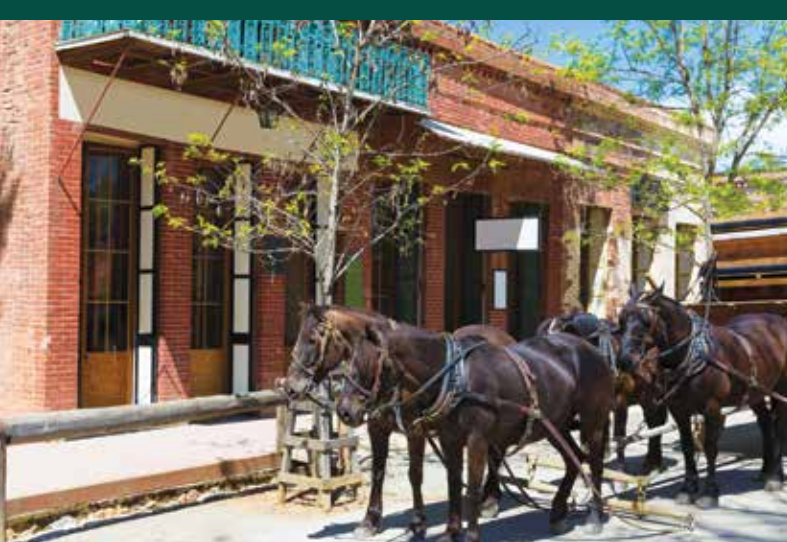

### Nearby Activities

**Yosemite National Park** - 22 miles from Yosemite Pines Resort to the Yosemite National Park Big Oak Flat entrance. Valley floor is an additional 24-mile drive from park gate. **YARTS** motor coach shuttles depart Yosemite Pines right to the Yosemite Valley Visitor's Center Spring through September. 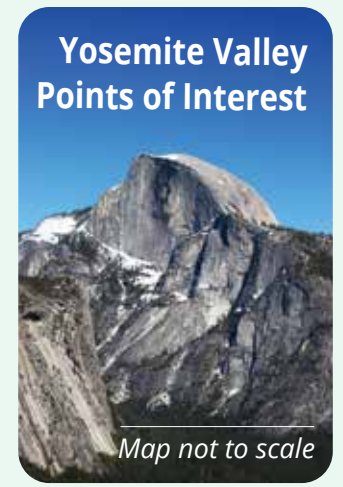

Most operators of Tuolumne River rafting trips meet here at La Casa Loma River Store parking lot, Ferretti Rd. & Hwy 120. Sunshine Rafting (Stanislaus River) meets in Knights Ferry.
